Construction Notice: Valley Line West LRT

Elevated Guideway Construction on 87 Avenue between 170 Street and Misericordia Hospital Entrance

Edmonton

On December 17, 2021, Marigold Infrastructure Partners will begin drilling piers for the elevated guideway at Misericordia Hospital.

Drilling will begin at the northeast corner of 170 Street and 87 Avenue and will move eastward toward the hospital entrance. Most work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. – 9 p.m. Monday - Saturday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Sundays), however, some overnight work will be required.

At least twice each week, drilling activities will begin at 3 a.m. This activity is expected to last approximately four hours and the following concrete pour will is expected to last another six hours.

This work is expected to last until mid-January, however, there will be a pause in works over the holiday season.



87 Avenue between 170 Street and Misericordia Hospital Entrance

Impacts to the public:

- There will be increased construction traffic to the worksite.
- There may be periodic traffic disruptions associated with the construction of the elevated guideway. The public will be notified ahead of these disruptions.
- Work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. 9 p.m. Monday Saturday, 9 a.m. 7 p.m. Sundays), however, some overnight work will be required.

- There will be noise associated with this work.
- There will be vibration during drilling.
- Noise and vibration will be monitored, and mitigation measures will be in place.
- Area residents can expect dust. Dust mitigation measures will be in place.
- For safety and security purposes, the area will be lit with work lights. MIP will ensure that these lights are not a hazard to nearby motorists or shining into local homes.
- There will be generators on site that may need to run overnight. Noise mitigation will be used to dampen the sound and reduce disturbance to the public.
- For safety and security purposes, the area will be under video surveillance.
- Access to Misericordia Hospital will be maintained.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the south side of 87 Avenue.
- This portion of the drilling program is expected to last until mid-January; however, construction of the elevated guideway (foundations, columns, and superstructure) is expected to last until 2025.

Marigold Infrastructure Partners is committed to following all City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations and has obtained an overnight roadwork permit so that work can take place during nighttime hours to minimize major daytime traffic disruptions. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600.

We ask for your understanding and patience as construction progresses.

The information in this bulletin is current to December 8, 2021. Please note that all dates are approximate and weather dependent. We thank you for your patience and understanding during the construction of the Valley Line West LRT project.
