

Construction Notice

Full Closure of Stony Plain Road Bridge and Groat Road from 107 Avenue to River Valley Road for Bridge Demolition AREA 3

On **December 29, 2022**, Marigold Infrastructure Partners will begin demolition of the Stony Plain Road Bridge. This work is required to rebuild a bridge wide enough to support vehicle, pedestrian, bicycle, and LRT traffic.

The Stony Plain Road Bridge Demolition will occur during daytime and overnight hours from 7 p.m. on December 29, 2022, to 6 a.m. on January 3, 2023.

The work will require two short-term closures of Groat Road between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road and the long-term closure of Stony Plain Road between 129 Street and 131 Street.



Short-term closure: Groat Road between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road December 29, 2022, to January 3, 2023

To accommodate the demolition and removal of the Stony Plain Road Bridge, Groat Road will be closed between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road. The road will close starting at 7 p.m. Thursday, December 29, 2022, and will re-open at 6 a.m. Tuesday, January 3, 2023.

During this time, pedestrian access on Groat Road will also be closed. Pedestrians are asked to use Ramsay Ravine, near Government House Park, as a detour.

** A second short-term closure will occur to install the new bridge. We anticipate this to take place in spring of 2023. The public will be notified in advance of this closure.*

Long-term closure: Stony Plain Road between 129 Street and 131 Street December 29, 2022, to fall 2024

To accommodate construction of the new Stony Plain Road Bridge, eastbound and westbound vehicle and pedestrian traffic across the bridge will be closed between 129 Street and 131 Street. This closure is expected to be in place until fall 2024.

During construction, vehicle and pedestrian traffic across Stony Plain Road Bridge will be detoured to 102 Avenue or 107 Avenue.

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- Traffic on **Stony Plain Road** between 129 Street and 131 Street will be closed from **7 p.m. December 29, 2022, until fall 2024**. Traffic will be detoured to 102 Avenue or 107 Avenue.
- **Groat Road** between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road will be closed from **7 p.m. December 29, 2022, to 6 a.m. January 3, 2023**.

Pedestrians:

- Eastbound/westbound pedestrian access across **Stony Plain Road Bridge** will be detoured to 102 Avenue or 107 Avenue until **fall 2024**.
- Northbound/southbound access on **Groat Road** will be detoured to Ramsay Ravine near Government House Park from **7 p.m. December 29, 2022, to 6 a.m. January 3, 2023**.

Other impacts:

- There will be noise associated with this work such as that of heavy equipment. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
- Construction of the new Stony Plain Road Bridge will primarily occur during daytime hours; however, some overnight work may be necessary.
- Construction of the new bridge is expected to last until fall 2024.

Marigold Infrastructure Partners is committed to following all City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations and will obtain an overnight roadwork permit so work can take place during nighttime hours to minimize major daytime traffic disruptions. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600.
