

Construction Update

Access Change at 104 Street and 105 Street near 102 Avenue

AREA 1

This is a supplemental notice for work previously mentioned in the following notice:

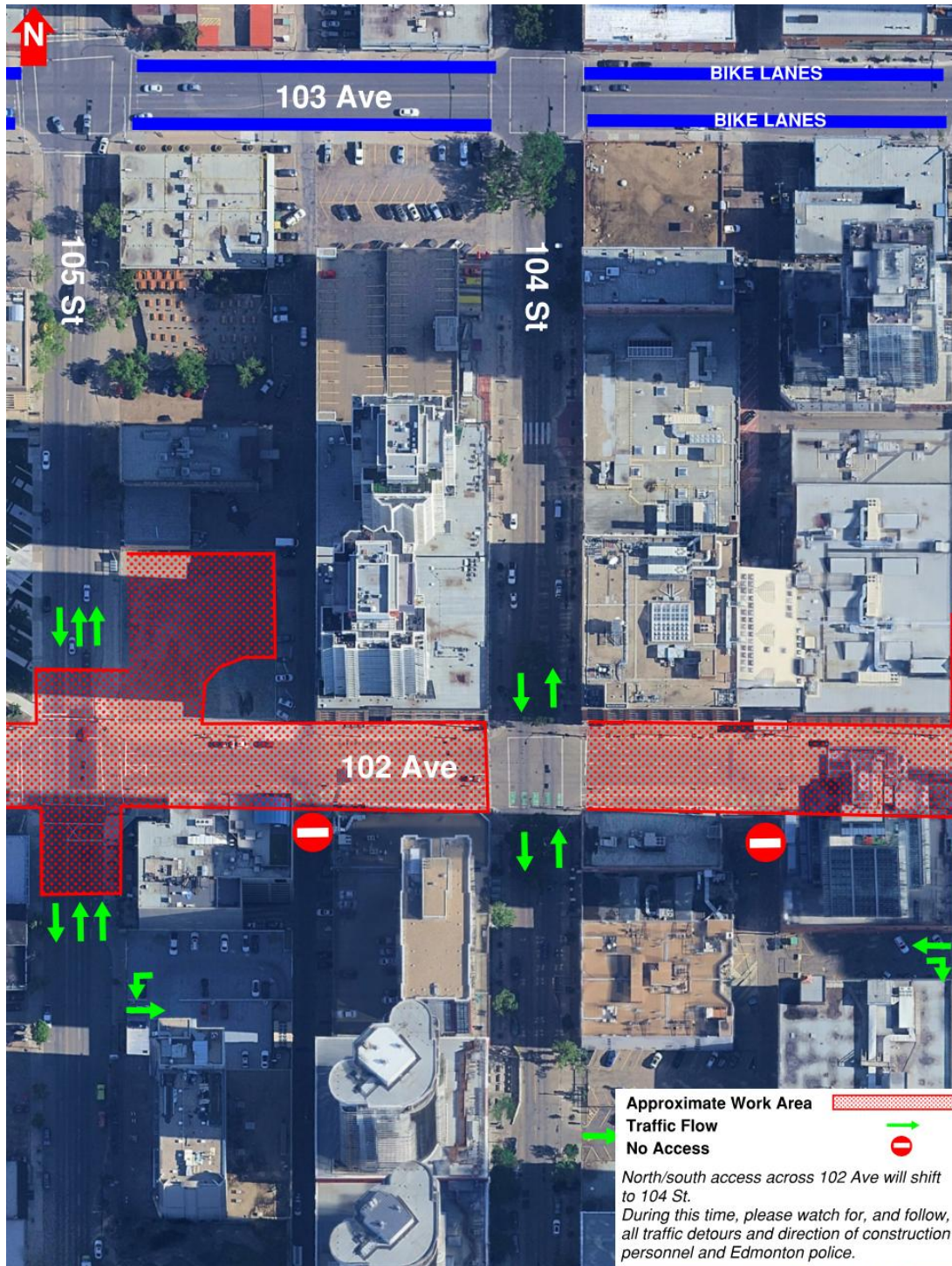
On **July 15, 2026**, north/south traffic across 102 Avenue will move to 104 Street from 105 Street. Vehicular traffic on 102 Avenue between 107 Street and 102 Street is currently closed.

Pedestrian access is maintained; however, detours are in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage. Pedestrian maps of the area are accessible by using the [102 Avenue Pedestrian Wayfinding Map](#) QR code, which is posted throughout the area and updated regularly.

Construction will continue during daytime hours (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday). This configuration is expected to remain in place until the end of 2026.

Valley Line West LRT

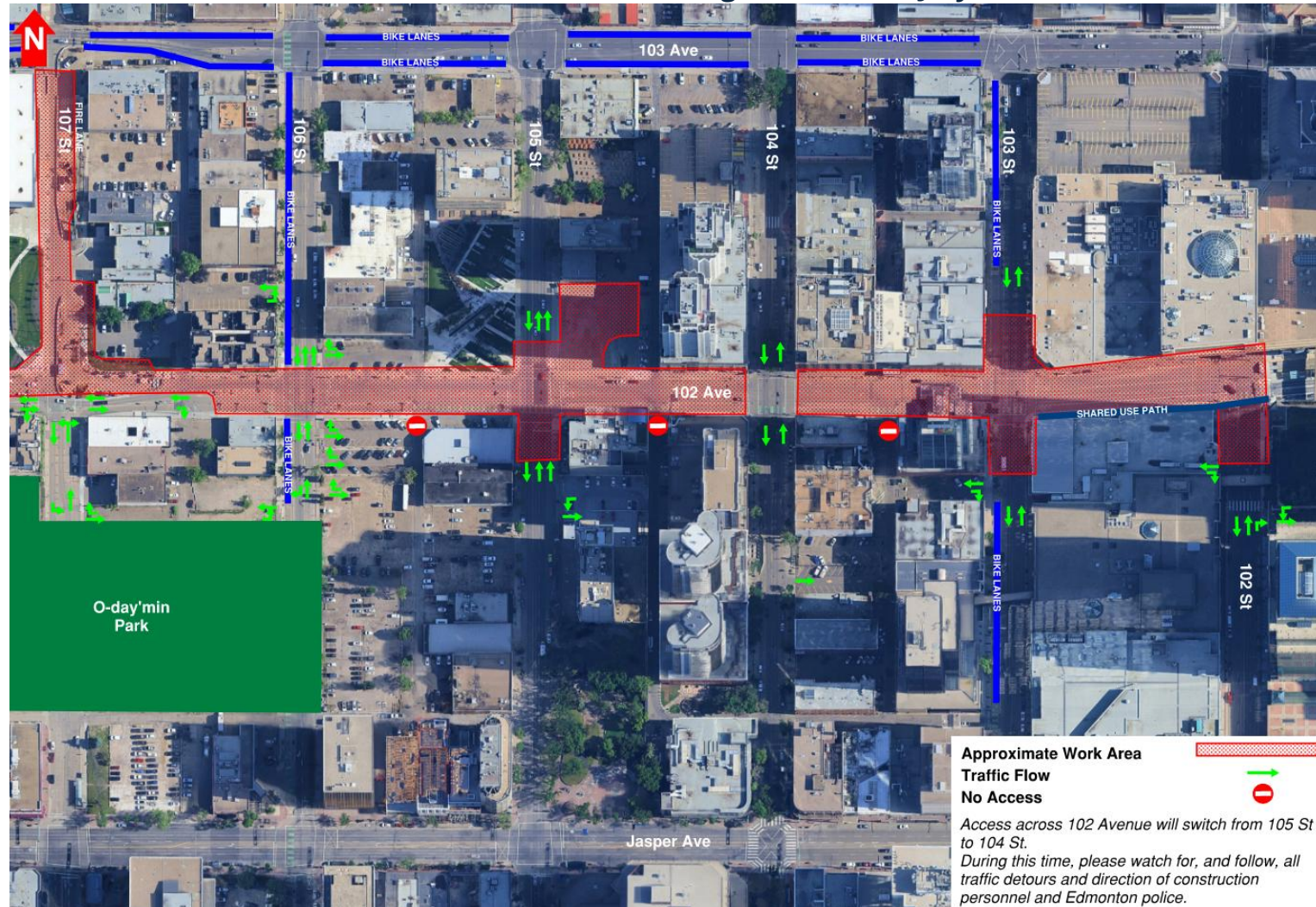
102 Avenue between 104 Street and 105 Street

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- North/south access across 102 Avenue will move to 104 Street from 105 Street.
- Eastbound through traffic on 102 Avenue between 107 Street and 102 Street is banned.
- Vehicle access to Fountain Tire will be maintained via the north/south alley between 105 Street and 106 Street.
- **North/south access across 102 Avenue on 104 Street will be unavailable during the [Downtown Farmers' Market](#).**

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be in place.
- Cyclists must dismount and walk their bicycles across 102 Avenue on 106 Street and on 103 Street. A shared use path (SUP) is on 102 Avenue between 103 Street and 102 Street.
- Pedestrian maps of the area are accessible by utilizing the [102 Avenue Pedestrian Wayfinding Map](#) QR code, which is posted throughout the area and updated regularly.
- Please follow project wayfinding signage.

Other impacts:

- Construction will mainly occur during daytime hours (Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.).
- Overnight work is required. Marigold has issued the following notice, in accordance with *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600 [Overnight Work on 102 Avenue between 107 Street and 102 Street](#)
- There will be noise and vibration associated with this work, including that of heavy equipment, and increased construction vehicle traffic in the area. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.

- Access to nearby businesses and residences will be maintained; however, detours will be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.
- Construction is anticipated to continue until the end of 2026.
