

## Construction Notice

### Preparatory Works on 87 Avenue Between 190 Street and Anthony Henday Drive Bridge Area 7

On or around **September 18, 2023**, Marigold Infrastructure Partners will begin work to prepare the area of 87 Avenue between 190 Street and Anthony Henday Drive Bridge for upcoming drainage activities. This will include the installation of temporary streetlights and traffic signals, the removal of concrete sidewalks and medians, and then temporarily repaving the area. Once this work is complete, traffic can be shifted onto this cleared space allowing drainage work to begin.

This work will be performed in several phases during daytime hours (Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.) and crews will be working in multiple areas simultaneously.

1. 87 Avenue, west exit of the Parkwest Business Complex – westbound lane closure.
2. 87 Avenue near 190 Street centre median – westbound lane closures.
3. Marigold Site Office – no public impact.
4. 87 Avenue near 190 Street and Anthony Henday Drive Bridge – westbound lane closure.
5. 87 Avenue at the Anthony Henday Drive Bridge, centre median – westbound to northbound curb (on ramp) lane closure. Turn movements will be maintained.
6. 87 Avenue at Anthony Henday Drive Bridge – eastbound lane closure.
7. 87 Avenue at Anthony Henday Drive Bridge (eastbound to northbound on ramp) – no lane closure required.

To accommodate this, traffic will be shifted away from the work sites and lane reductions will be in place. Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be implemented. Please follow project wayfinding signage.

This work is expected to last three weeks.

## 87 Avenue Between 190 Street and Anthony Henday Drive Bridge



### To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

#### Drivers:

- Traffic on 87 Avenue between 190 Street and the Anthony Henday Drive Bridge will be temporarily shifted away from the work zones.
- Turn movements will be maintained.
- Traffic lanes will be reopened once work in the area has been completed.

#### Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage.
- Pedestrian detours will remain in place until work is completed.

#### Other impacts:

- Construction work will occur during daytime hours (Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.).
- There will be noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
