

Winter Works

Winter Construction on 104 Avenue, Stony Plain Road, 156 Street/Meadowlark Road and 87 Avenue

2023 has been another busy year for Marigold Infrastructure Partners, building Edmonton's Valley Line West LRT. We've made major progress along the route and Marigold crews will continue construction of the Valley Line West throughout the winter months.

Area 1 (102 Avenue & 102-107 Street)

Upcoming Drainage Work on 107 Street between 102 Avenue and 104 Avenue

Drainage work is expected to begin on 107 Street in the new year. Traffic disruptions and pedestrian detours can be expected. More details to come.



Area 2 (104 Avenue & 107-121 Street)

Ongoing Drainage Work on 104 Avenue between 107 Street and 121 Street

Drainage work continues along 104 Avenue between 107 Street and 121 Street. To accommodate this:

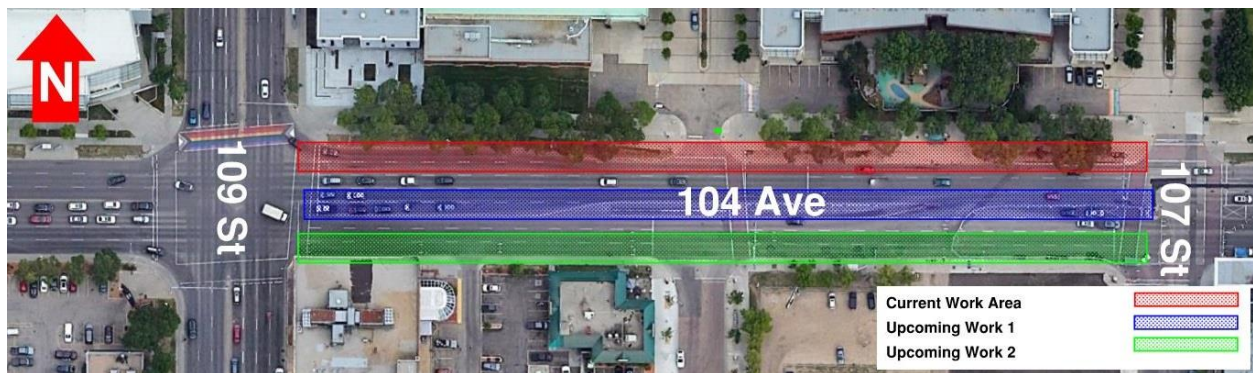
- Access to Edmonton Brewery District, Unity Square Centre, and MacEwan University will be maintained; however, access closures may be in place.
- Pedestrian access is maintained; however, detours can be expected. Please follow area wayfinding signage.

104 Avenue between 107 Street and 109 Street

This is a supplemental notice for work previously mentioned in the following notice:

[Lane Closures on 104 Avenue Between 107 Street and 109 Street for Drainage Work](#)

Between 107 Street and 109 Street, work is expected to continue on the north side of 104 Avenue until mid-December. Following this, the work zone will move to the middle of the avenue, and then to the south side of the road. We anticipate this work to be complete by the end of January.



104 Avenue between 110 Street and 122 Street

Drainage work continues on the north side of 104 Avenue between 110 Street and 121 Street and is expected to last until spring 2024.



Area 3 (104 Avenue/Stony Plain Road & 121-139 Street)

Ongoing Drainage Work on Stony Plain Road between 123 Street and 129 Street

This is a supplemental notice for work previously mentioned in the following notice:

Lane Closures on Stony Plain Road Between 123 Street and 129 Street

Drainage work continues on Stony Plain Road between 123 Street and 129 Street and is expected to last until spring 2024. To accommodate this:

- Traffic is reduced to a single lane in either direction.
- Intermittent access closures to/from the north side of Stony Plain Road from cross streets and alleys can be expected. Only one access will be closed at a time.
- Access to/from Stony Plain Road at 129 St will be closed for the duration of this work.



Stony Plain Road Bridge Construction

Construction of the Stony Plain Road Bridge over Groat Road continues with an anticipated opening date of fall 2024.

Stony Plain Road Full Closure between 131 Street and 139 Street

This stretch of Stony Plain Road re-opened at the end of November. Traffic in the area has been permanently reduced to a single lane in either direction and most adjacent streets will be right in/right out only.

East/west pedestrian access will be maintained on the south side of the road, at this time.



Area 4 (Stony Plain Road & 139-156 Street / 156 Street & Stony Plain Road – 99 Avenue)

Ongoing Drainage Work on South Stony Plain Road between 142 Street and 156 Street

Traffic on Stony Plain Road between 142 Street and 156 Street is shifted north and permanently reduced to a single lane in either direction.

Lanes Re-opened Stony Plain Road/102 Avenue near 142 Street

A second eastbound lane on 102 Avenue east of 142 Street has been opened for the winter. The northbound to eastbound right turn bay on 142 Street has also been re-opened.

Lanes Re-opened Stony Plain Road at 149 Street

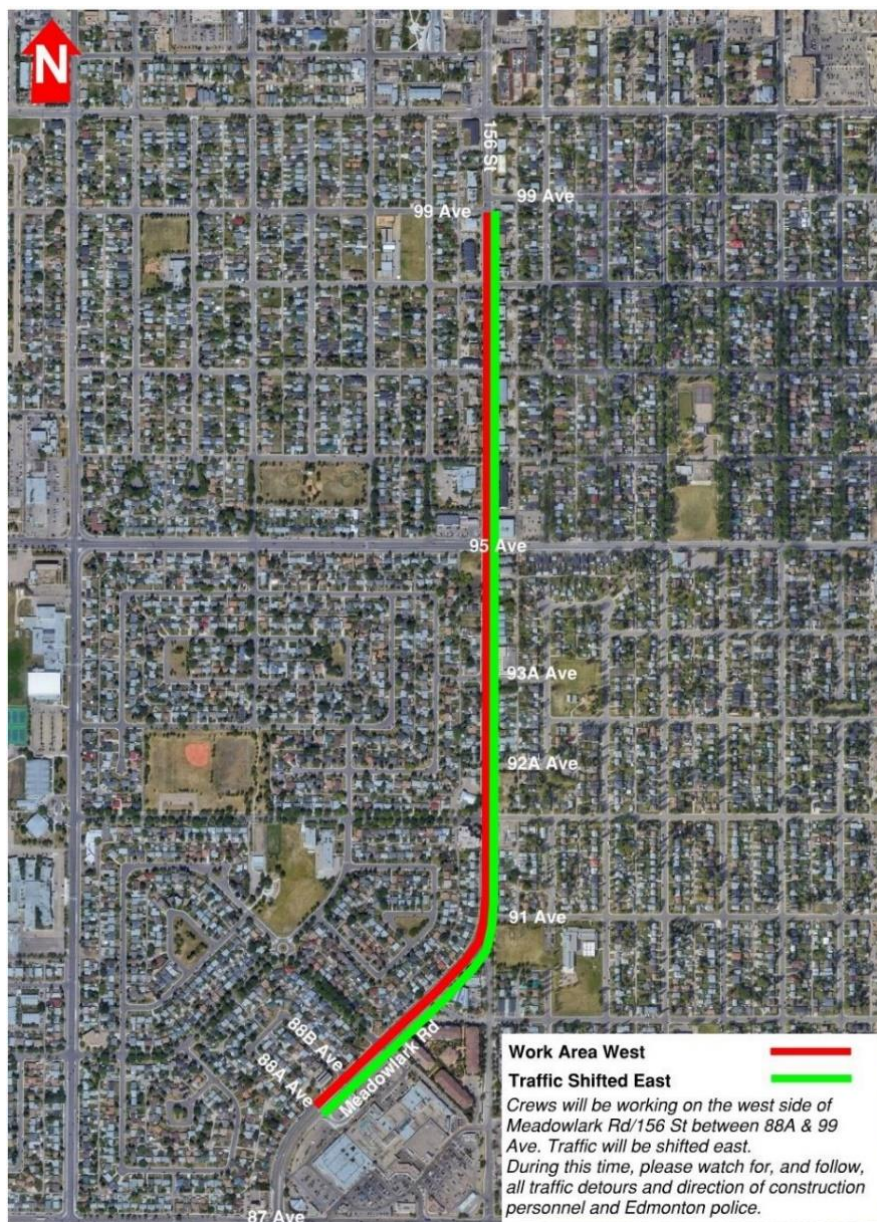
The northbound to eastbound right turn bay on 149 Street has also been re-opened as well as dedicated north/south through lanes.

Area 5 (156 Street & 99 Ave-Meadowlark Road / Meadowlark Road – 98 Ave & 163 Street)

156 Street/Meadowlark Road

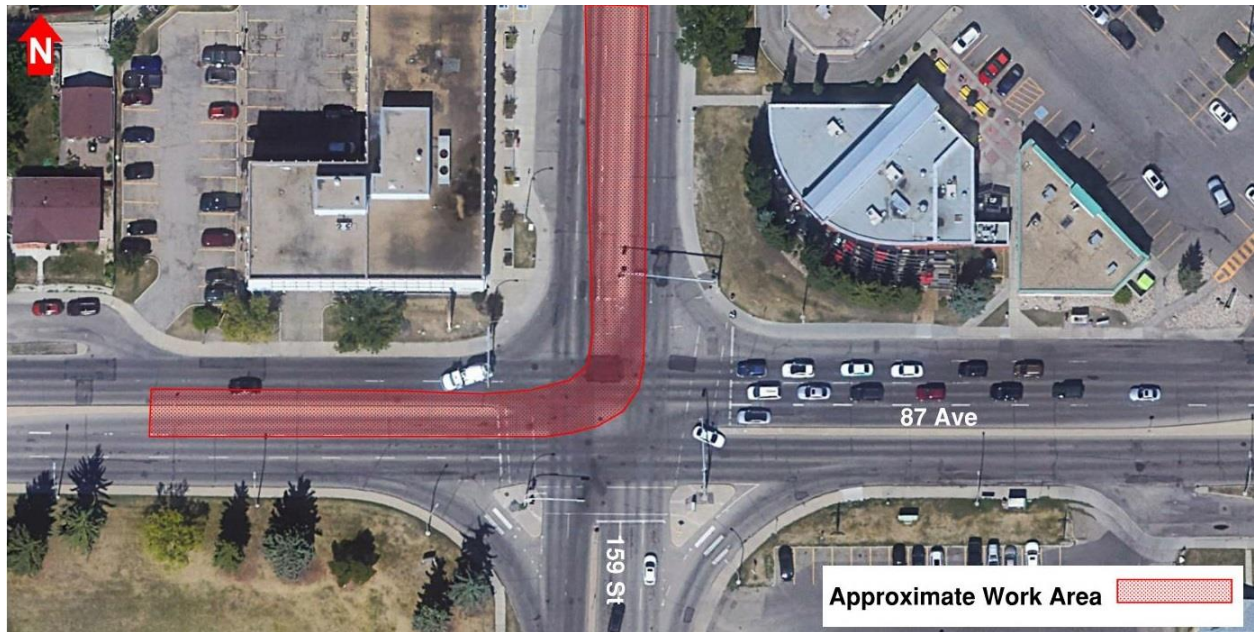
Drainage work will continue throughout the winter on the west side of 156 Street/Meadowlark Road. To accommodate this work, traffic on 156 Street/Meadowlark Road between 100 Avenue and 88A Avenue is shifted to the east side of the road.

Access to 156 Street/Meadowlark Road from adjacent avenues will be maintained; however, intermittent closures may be required. The public will be notified of these closures in advance of this work.



Overhead Catenary System Pile (OCS) Construction at 159 Street and 87 Avenue

Crews expect to begin drilling the piles for the OCS poles this winter. The Overhead Catenary System is a system of overhead wires used to supply electricity to the light rail vehicle (LRV). More details to come.



Area 6 (87 Avenue & 163 Street - Anthony Henday Drive) 87 Avenue Between 159 Street and Anthony Henday Drive

The Gantry Crane has been winterized and will resume operations in the spring. Crews continue to construct the piers and approaches for the elevated guideway along 87 Avenue.

Traffic in this area is shifted away from the work sites and lane reductions are in place. Turn movements are maintained where access permits.

Pedestrian access is maintained; however, detours are in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage.

Area 7 (Anthony Henday Drive) Anthony Henday LRT Bridge Construction

The new LRT Bridge over Anthony Henday Drive is taking shape, and the girder installation is expected to occur in mid-January. More details to come.

Area 8 (87 Avenue /Webber Greens Drive & Anthony Henday Drive – Lewis Farm Transit Centre)

Work continues on the Light Maintenance Facility and the Lewis Farms Stop.

Area 9 (Gerry Wright Operations & Maintenance Facility-OMF / 75 Street & Whitemud Drive)

Work continues on the Operations & Maintenance Facility.
