

Construction Notice

Full Closure of Stony Plain Road Bridge and Groat Road from River Valley Road to 107 Avenue for Bridge Demolition AREA 3

In late December, Marigold Infrastructure Partners will begin the demolition of the Stony Plain Road Bridge. This work is required to rebuild a bridge wide enough to support vehicle, pedestrian, bicycle, and LRT traffic.

This work will require two short-term closures of Groat Road between 102 Avenue and 107 Avenue and the long-term closure of Stony Plain Road between 129 Street and 131 Street.

Short-term Closure of Groat Road between 102 Avenue and 107 Avenue – Late December

To demolish and remove the Stony Plain Road Bridge, Groat Road will be closed between 102 Avenue and 107 Avenue. A second closure will occur when the new bridge is installed.*

During bridge demolition, pedestrian access on Groat Road will also be closed. Pedestrians are asked to use Ramsay Ravine, near Government House Park, as a detour.

Bridge demolition will occur during daytime and overnight hours.

** We anticipate the second closure to take place in spring of 2023. The public will be notified in advance of this closure.*

Long-term Closure of Stony Plain Road Bridge between 129 Street and 131 Street – Late December 2022 to Fall 2024

To accommodate construction of the new bridge, eastbound and westbound traffic across the bridge will be closed between 129 Street and 131 Street. This closure is expected to be in place until fall 2024.

During construction, vehicle and pedestrian traffic across Stony Plain Road Bridge will be detoured to 102 or 107 Avenue.

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

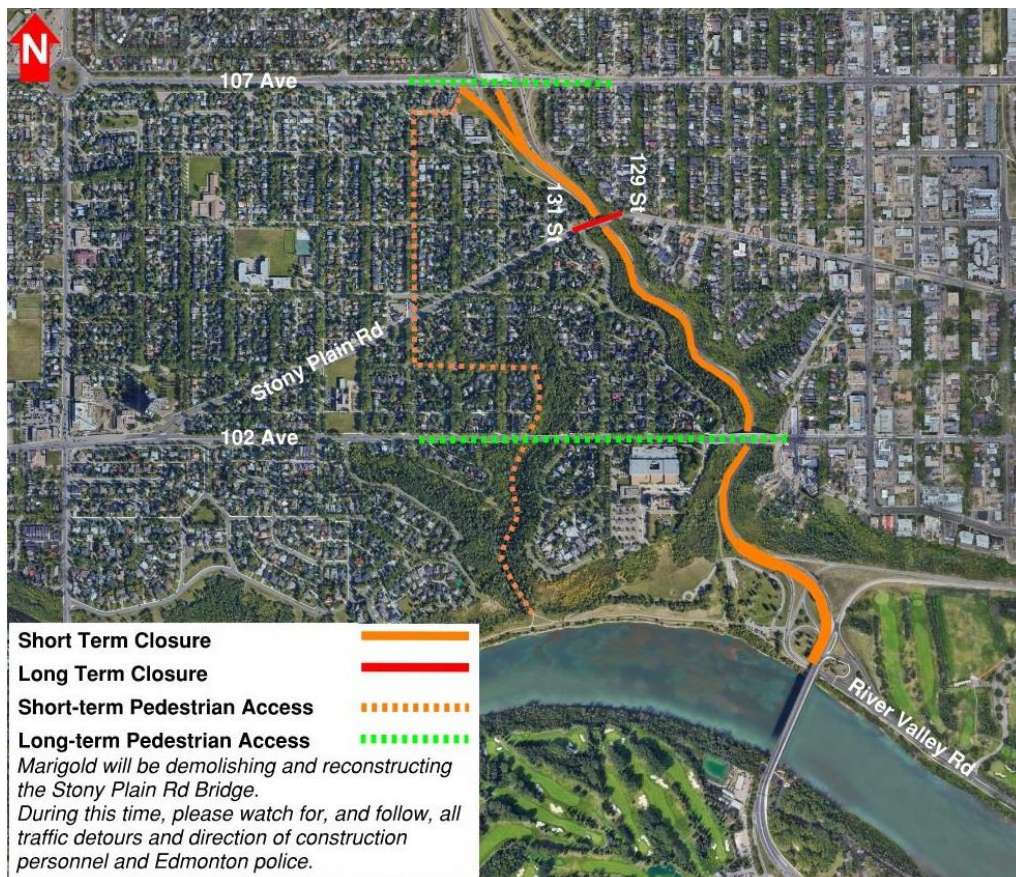
- Traffic on Stony Plain Road between 129 and 131 Streets will be closed until summer 2024. Traffic will be detoured to 102 or 107 Avenues.
- Traffic on Groat Road between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road will be closed for approximately four days over a weekend.

Pedestrians:

- Eastbound/westbound pedestrian access on Stony Plain Road will be detoured to 102 or 107 Avenues until summer 2024.
- Northbound/southbound access on Groat Road will be detoured to Ramsay Ravine near Government House Park approximately four days over a weekend.

Other impacts:

- Demolition and removal of Stony Plain Road Bridge will occur during daytime and overnight hours approximately four days over a weekend.
- Construction of the new Stony Plain Road Bridge will primarily occur during daytime hours; however, some overnight work may be necessary.
- There will be noise associated with this work such as that of heavy equipment. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
- Construction of the new bridge is expected to last until summer 2024.



Marigold Infrastructure Partners is committed to following all City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations and will obtain an overnight roadwork permit so that work can take place during nighttime hours to minimize major daytime traffic disruptions. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600.
