

## Construction Notice

### Lane Shift on 87 Avenue between 165 Street and 170 Street

On or around **November 25, 2022**, Marigold Infrastructure crews will begin works to construct the Misericordia station structures.

To accommodate this, eastbound and westbound traffic on 87 Avenue between 165 Street and 170 Street will be shifted south, away from the work site. Two lanes of traffic and all turn movements will be maintained.

Pedestrian access to the Misericordia Hospital will be maintained; however, detours may be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.

Construction will primarily occur during the day (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday), however, occasional overnight work may be necessary. The public will be notified in advance of this work. Traffic interruptions will occur during peak, off-peak, and overnight hours.

This work is expected to last until Spring 2023.

## To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

### Drivers:

- Traffic on 87 Avenue will be shifted south.
- Two lanes of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- Turn movements will be maintained.

### Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian access to the Misericordia Hospital will be maintained.
- Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.

### Other impacts:

- Construction work will primarily occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday)
- Traffic interruptions will occur during peak, off-peak hours, and overnight hours.
- There will be noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
