

Construction Notice

Access Closures on Stony Plain Road at 122 Street (North)

AREA 3

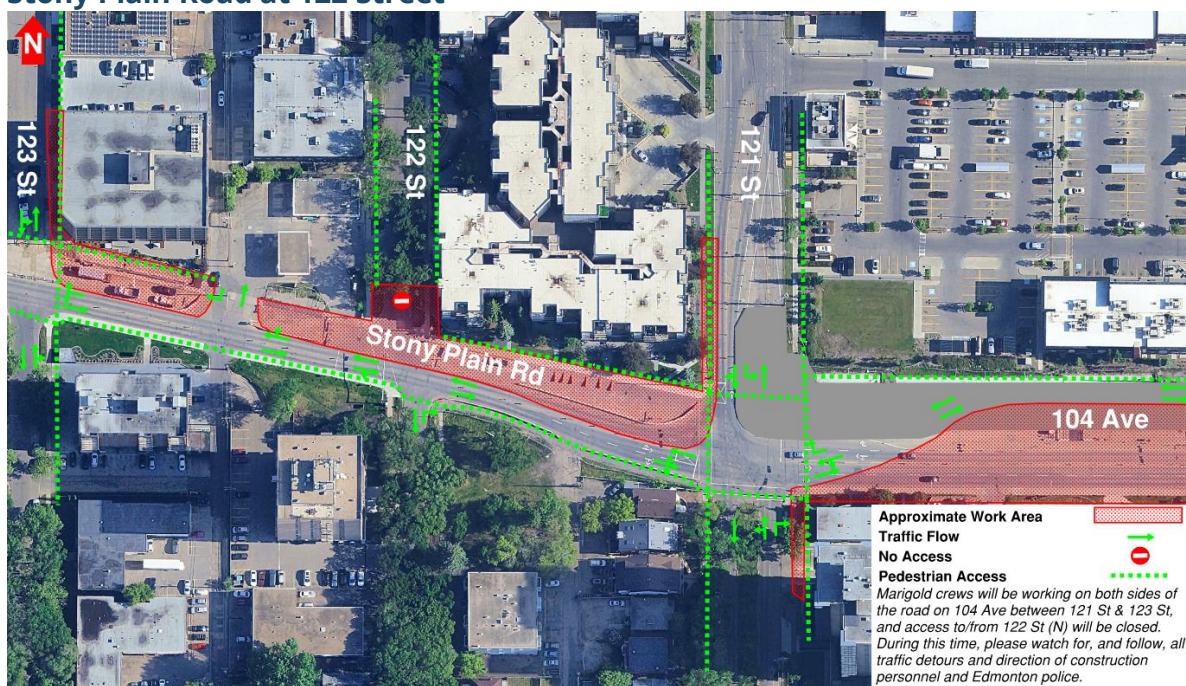
On or around **April 22, 2025**, Marigold crews will be resuming roadworks on the north side of Stony Plain Road between 121 Street and 123 Street.

To accommodate this work, access to/from Stony Plain Road from the north side of 122 Street will be closed. Traffic between 121 Street and 123 Street will be shifted south and permanently reduced to a single lane in either direction. Turn movements will be maintained where access permits.

Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.

This work will occur during daytime hours, (7 a.m. – 9 p.m. Monday – Saturday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Sundays). However, the closure will remain in place until the work is complete. This closure is expected to last eight weeks.

Stony Plain Road at 122 Street



To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- Access to/from Stony Plain Road from the north side of 122 Street will be closed.
- Traffic between 121 Street and 123 Street will be shifted south.
- Traffic on Stony Plain Road has been permanently reduced to a single lane in either direction.
- Turn movements will be maintained where access permits.

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained; however, detours will be in place.
- Please observe all project wayfinding signage in the area.
- The north/south bicycle lanes on 121 Street between 104 Avenue and 105 Avenue will be maintained.

Other impacts:

- Construction will mainly occur during daytime hours (Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.).
- Some overnight work may be required. If overnight work is required, Marigold will obtain an overnight roadwork permit, in accordance with City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600.
- This work is expected to last eight weeks.

The information in this bulletin is current to April 3, 2025. Please note that all dates are approximate and weather dependent. We thank you for your patience and understanding during the construction of the Valley Line West LRT project.
