Valley Line West LRT

Construction Notice Utility Relocations on 95 Avenue and 156 Street AREA 5

This is a supplemental notice for work previously mentioned in the following notice: <u>Utility</u> <u>Relocations on 156 Street/Meadowlark Road between 88 and 100 Avenue</u>

Marigold crews will relocate the utility line along Meadowlark Road/156 Street between 88 and 100 Avenue. The utility line currently sits in the middle of Meadowlark Road/156 Street. It will be shifted to the west side of the road and tie-ins (connections) to properties along 156 Street will be performed.

On **May 27 to May 29, 2022**, Marigold crews will be working in the intersection of 95 Avenue and 156 Street. To accommodate this work, eastbound traffic on 95 Avenue will be restricted to a single lane at 163 Street and detoured north at 157 Street. There will also be a single southbound lane closure south of 95 Avenue on 156 Street and traffic will be shifted around the worksite.

Motorists exiting the service road on the south side of 95 Avenue will be permitted to turn left from the alley behind the Marigold laydown yard. To travel east, please use the north detour at 157 Street.

This work will begin at 7 p.m. Friday, May 27 and is expected to be completed by 6 a.m. Monday, May 30. Work will occur during daytime and overnight hours.

Marigold Infrastructure Partners is committed to following all City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations and has obtained an overnight roadwork permit so that work can take place during nighttime hours to minimize major daytime traffic disruptions. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600.

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

- The work in the intersection will occur during daytime and overnight hours.
- Eastbound traffic on 95 Avenue will be reduced to a single lane at 163 Street and detoured north at 157 Street.
- Work in the intersection is expected to last from 7 p.m. Friday, May 27 6 a.m. Monday, May 30.
- Work will occur during daytime and overnight hours.
- Southbound traffic of 156 Street will be reduced to a single lane.
- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained; temporary detours may be in place, please observe all signage in the area.

- ETS access will be maintained.
- There will be parking restrictions in place while the work occurs.
- Marigold is aware of the residences in the area and will reduce disturbances as best as possible, such as scheduling the most disruptive to work to occur during daytime hours.
