

## Construction Notice

### Lane Closures on Stony Plain Road Between 124 Street and 129 Street Area 3

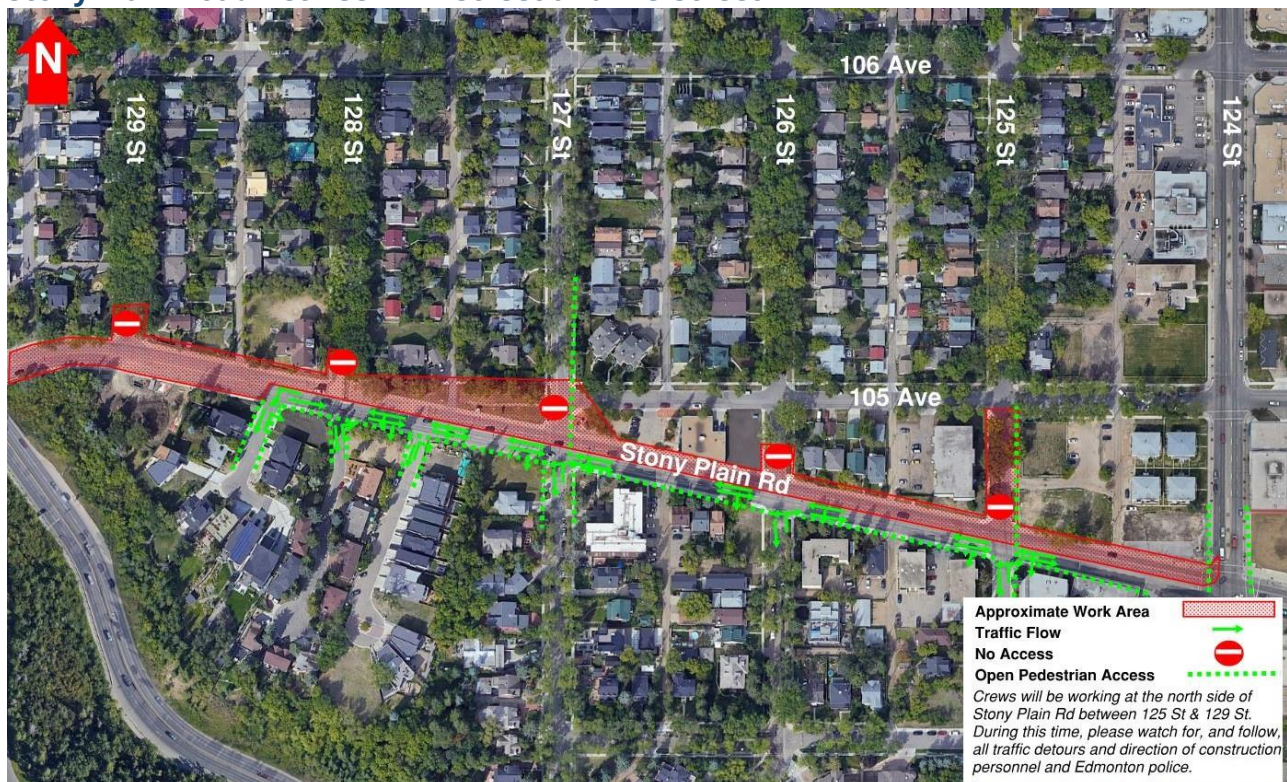
On or around **April 29, 2024**, Marigold Infrastructure Partners will begin road work on the north side of Stony Plain Road between 124 Street and 129 Street.

To accommodate this, traffic on 104 Avenue between 124 Street and Woodbend Place is shifted south and lane reductions are in place. Further, access to/from the north side of Stony Plain Road from 125 Street, 126 Street, 127 Street, 128 Street, and 129 Street will be closed.

Pedestrian access will be maintained on the south side of Stony Plain Road. Access across Stony Plain Road will be maintained at 125 Street and 127 Street. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area. The bicycle path on 127 Street will remain open.

Construction will occur during the day (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday). This work is expected to last until the end of October.

### Stony Plain Road Between 124 Street and 129 Street



## To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

### Drivers:

- Traffic on Stony Plain Road between 124 Street and Woodbend Place is shifted south away from the work zone.
- Lane reductions are in place on Stony Plain Road between 124 Street and 129 Street.
- There will be no access to/from the north side of Stony Plain Road between 124 Street and 129 Street.

### Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained on the south side of Stony Plain Road.
- Access across Stony Plain Road will be maintained at 125 Street and 127 Street.
- The bicycle path on 127 Street will be maintained.
- Please follow project wayfinding signage.

### Other impacts:

- Construction work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday).
- There will be noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.

- This work is expected to last until the end of October.
