

Neighbourhood Notice: Valley Line West LRT

Mobilization of the 156 Street & 100A Avenue

AREA 4

October 20, 2023 - In the coming weeks, Marigold Infrastructure Partners (MIP) will begin work to establish a utility complex on the north side of 100A Avenue, west of 156 Street. The utility complex acts as a substation for the electrical power supply for the LRT's Overhead Catenary System.

156 Street and 100A Avenue



Most of this work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. – 9 p.m.); however, occasional overnight work can be expected. Marigold Infrastructure Partners is committed to following all City of Edmonton bylaws and regulations and, when these situations arise, will obtain an overnight roadwork permit so that work can take place during nighttime hours in order to minimize major daytime traffic disruptions. *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600. The public will be notified ahead of these works.

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

- There will be increased traffic to and from the work site.
- Noise can be expected during construction; however, crews will perform their duties on site with the care, attention and respect as if their families lived on the neighbouring properties.

- Heavy machinery and drilling rigs will be using to drill piles when establishing the Utility Complex.
- Construction work will create dust. Dust mitigation measures will be in place.
- Crews will be mindful of equipment that creates noise or exhaust fume and will do their best to place this type of equipment in a location to avoid the potential of impacting a resident's home.
- For safety and security purposes, the area will be lit with work lights. MIP will ensure that these lights are not a hazard to nearby motorists or shining into local homes.
- The work area will be kept clean, and debris will be removed from the area frequently.
- Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
