

Construction Update

Access Change at 106 Street and 107 Street near 102 Avenue AREA 1

On or around **August 19, 2026**, vehicular access at 106 Street and 107 Street near 102 Avenue will change:

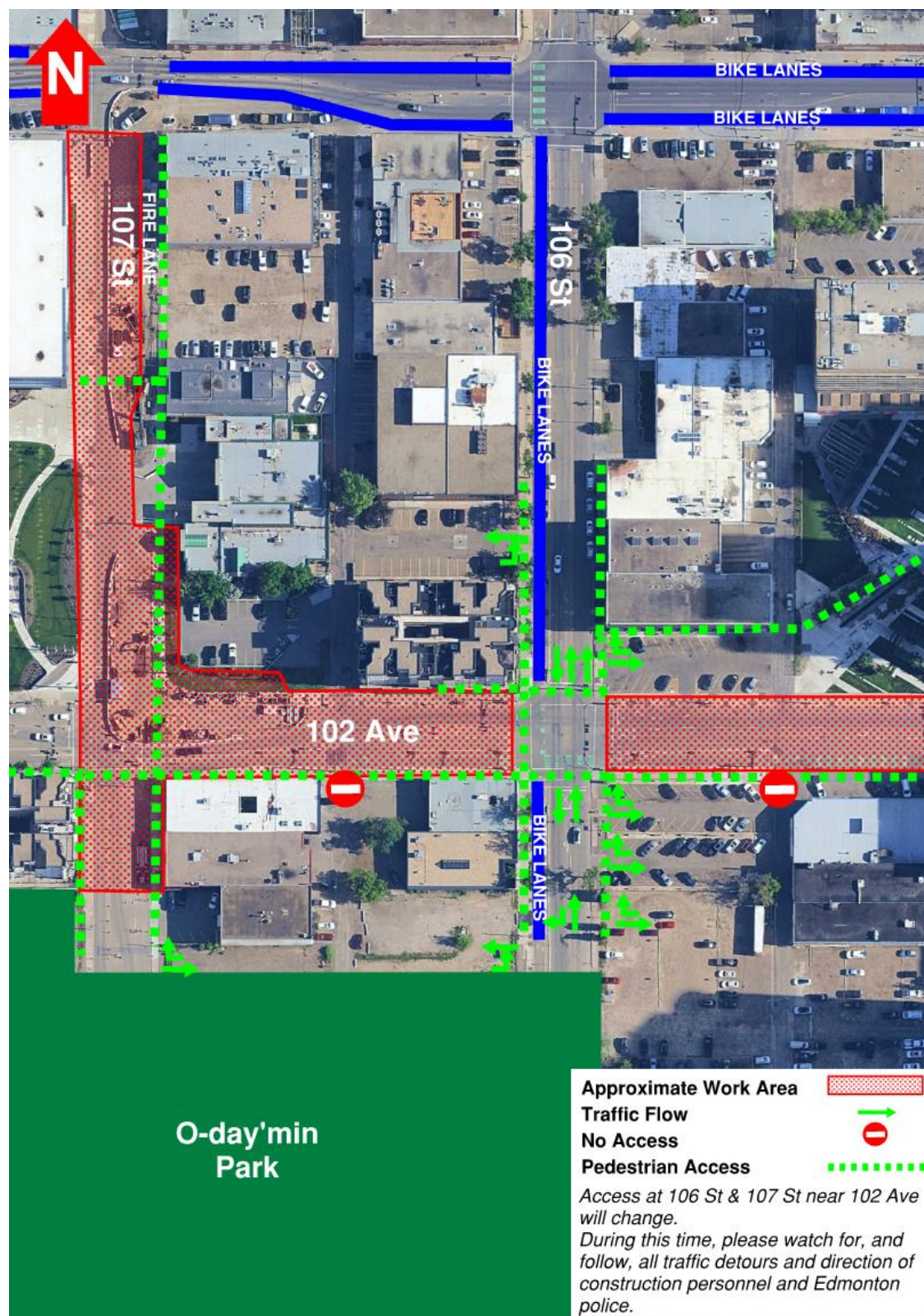
- the intersection of 107 Street and 102 Avenue will close to vehicle traffic and
- the intersection of 106 Street at 102 Avenue will reopen to north and southbound traffic.*

**North/south traffic on 106 Street between Jasper Avenue and the alley south of 102 Avenue may be impacted by ongoing roadwork around O-day'min Park and private developer work. Information about this work and related impacts can be found [here](#).*

Pedestrian access is maintained; however, detours are in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage. Pedestrian maps of the area are accessible by using the [102 Avenue Pedestrian Wayfinding Map](#) QR code, which is posted throughout the area and updated regularly.

The closure of 102 Avenue between 107 Street and 102 Street is expected to remain in place until the end of 2026.

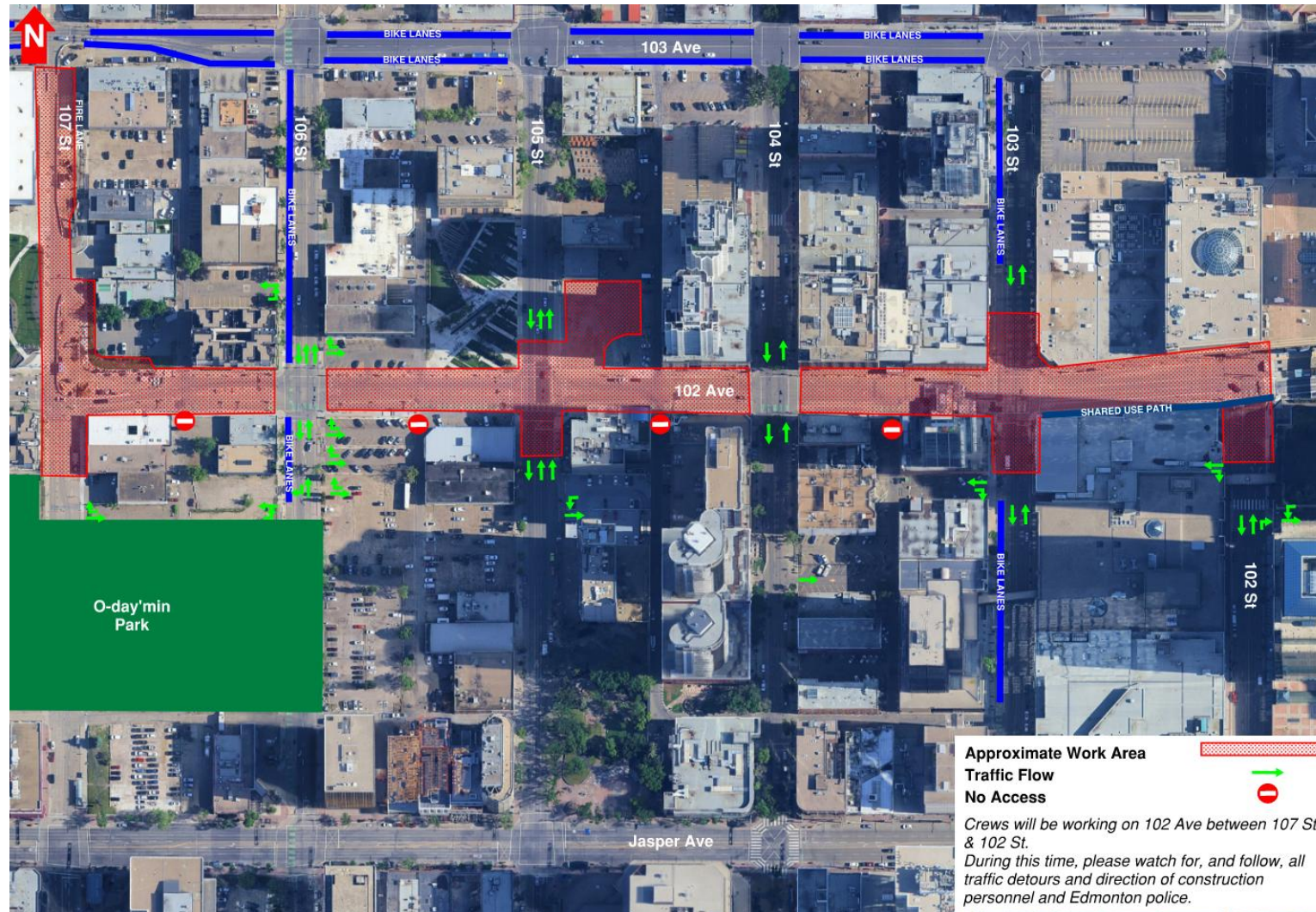
102 Avenue between 106 Street and 107 Street

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- North/south access across 102 Avenue will reopen at 106 Street.
- North/south traffic on 106 Street between Jasper Avenue and the alley south of 102 Avenue may be impacted by ongoing roadwork around O-day'min Park and private developer work. Information about this work and related impacts can be found [here](#).
- Vehicle traffic at the intersection of 102 Avenue and 107 Street will close. Northbound traffic is already banned at this intersection.
- 107 Street between 102 Avenue and 103 Avenue will remain open for Fire Station access only.
- Vehicle access to businesses on the south side of 102 Avenue between 106 Street and 107 Street (See Zen Benevolent Society, Edmonton Law Office, Alberta Craft Council, and Autograph Group) will be maintained via the east/west alley south of 102 Avenue off 106 Street.
- Vehicle access to Diamond Parking on 106 Street will be maintained from 106 Street, south of 102 Avenue, and from the alley between 105 Street and 106 Street.

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be in place.
- Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.
- A shared use path (SUP) has been established on 102 Avenue between 103 Street and 102 Street. Pedestrian maps of the area are accessible by utilizing the [102 Avenue Pedestrian Wayfinding Map](#) QR code, which is posted throughout the area and updated regularly.
- Please follow project wayfinding signage.

Other impacts:

- Construction will mainly occur during daytime hours (Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. and Sunday, 9 a.m. to 7 p.m.).
- Overnight work is required. Marigold has issued the following notice, in accordance with *City of Edmonton Bylaw C14600 [Overnight Work on 102 Avenue between 107 Street and 102 Street](#)
- There will be noise and vibration associated with this work, including that of heavy equipment, and increased construction vehicle traffic in the area. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.

- Access to nearby businesses and residences will be maintained; however, detours will be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.
- This configuration is expected to remain in place until the end of 2026.
