

## Construction Notice

### Anthony Henday LRT Bridge Piling Construction Prep Area 7

On or around **December 12, 2022**, Marigold Infrastructure crews will begin installation of driven steel piles for the LRT bridge abutment with work commencing on the west side of the Anthony Henday Drive along 87 Avenue.

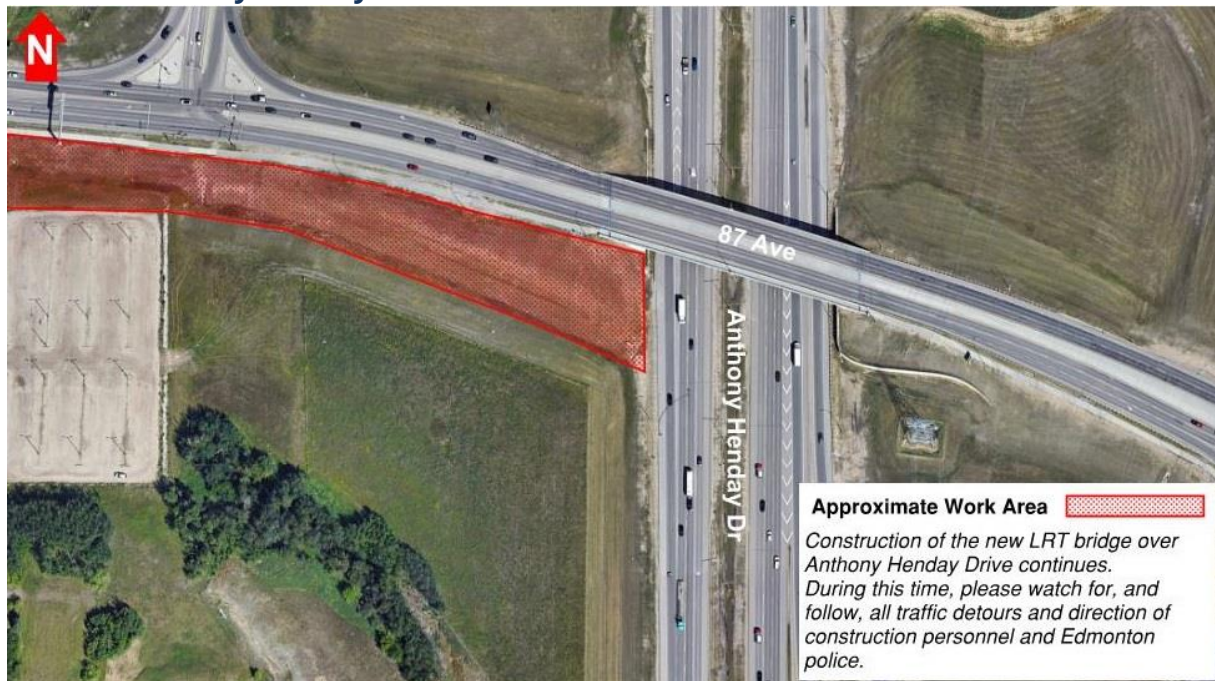
A total of 283 driven steel piles will be installed in the presence of a rotary drilling rig, piling rig, cranes, loaders, tandem dump trucks, and ready-mix concrete trucks.

This work is expected to generate a noticeable increase in the amount of noise and vibration near the construction area. While noise and vibration are unavoidable in any construction project, Marigold is committed to minimizing noise and vibration impacts along the alignment during construction.

Construction will primarily occur during the day (7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Saturday and 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. Sunday), however, occasional overnight work may be necessary. The public will be notified in advance of this work.

This work is expected to last nine months.

## To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

### Drivers:

- There will be no impacts to traffic.

### Pedestrians:

- There will be no impacts to pedestrians.

### Other Impacts:

- Most work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. – 9 p.m. Monday - Saturday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Sundays), however, some overnight work will be required. The public will be notified ahead of overnight work commencing.
- There will be noise associated with this work.
- There may be vibration during construction.
- Noise and vibration will be monitored, and mitigation measures will be in place.
- Area residents can expect dust. [Dust mitigation measures](#) will be in place.
- For safety and security purposes, the area may be lit with [work lights](#). Marigold will ensure that these lights are not a hazard to motorists or shining into nearby homes.
- There may be generators on site that may need to run overnight. [Noise mitigation](#) will be used to dampen the sound and reduce disturbance to the public.
- Marigold will make every effort to limit work that causes noise and vibrations to occur during daytime hours.
- This work is expected to last nine months.
