Construction Notice

Drainage Works on 156 Street at 100 Avenue AREA 4

On or around **March 21, 2024,** Marigold crews will begin drainage works at the intersection of 156 Street and 100 Avenue.

This work will be performed in three phases. To accommodate this work, traffic on 156 Street and on 100 Avenue will be shifted away from the work site and a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.

Pedestrian access will be maintained; however, detours will be in place. Please follow project wayfinding signage in the area.

This work will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. – 9 p.m. Monday – Saturday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m. Sundays), and is expected to last approximately three weeks at each location.

- Phase One Southwest corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue.
- Phase Two Northwest corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue.
- Phase Three Northeast corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue.

Approximate Work Area Traffic Flow Open Pedestrian Access Crews will be working at the southwest corner of the 156 St & 100 Ave intersection. During this time, please watch for, and follow, all traffic detours and direction of construction personnel and Edmonton police.

Phases One - Southwest corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- Traffic on 156 Street will be shifted east.
- Traffic on 100 Avenue will be shifted north.
- On 156 Street a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- On 100 Avenue a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- Left turns will be banned at this intersection.
- Right turns will be maintained.

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained; temporary detours will be in place.
- Please observe all project wayfinding signage in the area.

Approximate Work Area Traffic Flow **Open Pedestrian Access** Crews will be working at the northwest corner of the 156 St & 100 Ave intersection. During this time, please watch for, and follow, all traffic detours and direction of construction personnel and Edmonton police.

Phase Two - Northwest corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- Traffic on 156 Street will be shifted east.
- Traffic on 100 Avenue will be shifted south.
- On 156 Street a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- On 100 Avenue a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- Left turns will be banned at this intersection.
- Right turns will be maintained.

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained; temporary detours will be in place.
- Please observe all project wayfinding signage in the area.

Phase Three - Southeast corner of 156 Street and 100 Avenue

To accommodate this work, the public will be impacted in the following areas:

Drivers:

- Traffic on 156 Street will be shifted west.
- Traffic on 100 Avenue will be shifted north.
- On 156 Street a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- On 100 Avenue a single lane of traffic in either direction will be maintained.
- Left turns will be banned at this intersection.
- Right turns will be maintained.

Pedestrians:

- Pedestrian traffic will be maintained; temporary detours will be in place.
- Please observe all project wayfinding signage in the area.

Other impacts for all phases:

- Construction will occur during daytime hours (7 a.m. 9 p.m. Monday Saturday, 9 a.m. 7 p.m. Sundays).
- Access to local businesses and residences will be maintained.
- There will be noise associated with this work. Every effort will be made to reduce the impact to the public.
- This work is expected to last approximately three weeks at each location.
